

# Vehicles Registering over 105,500 lbs Gross Weight Must Purchase a Special Permit

As of March 1, 2024, all vehicles registering in Idaho over the 105,500 lbs limit will be required to provide proof of the Extra Length/Excess Weight Up To 129K permit or to purchase the permit at the time of registration.

It is unlawful for anyone to exceed the 105,500 lbs limit on any roadway in Idaho without the permit mentioned above. This helps carriers comply with Idaho Code 49-1001(1)(c).

This permit requirement is not new; it has been in place for quite some time. However, the Department has seen an increase in trucks hauling over 105,500 lbs without a permit.

We are providing this notice as a reminder to allow trucks an opportunity to come into compliance.
